Special Stage: SS21 Great Orme Llandudno 1 (8.03 km)

- 5. Thierry Neuville (BEL) / Nicolas Gilsoul (BEL) (Hyundai i20 Coupé WRC) It is actually very enjoyable, but I lost the bite on the brakes towards the end so I had to be careful!
- 6. Hayden Paddon (NZL) / Sebastian Marshall (GBR) (Hyundai i20 Coupé WRC) It was inevitable, it would be nice if we can all get infront of Mads. The pacenotes are a bit too slow.
- 4. Andreas Mikkelsen (NOR) / Anders Jaeger (NOR) (Hyundai i20 Coupé WRC) Around a right hand corner with negative camber I just lost the grip. The car is fine.

  I made a mistake here, I thought I was over the flying finish and I wasn't. I braked and switched it off but I wasn't there.

We are where we wanted to be and will defend third. There is no instruction from the team but I think they would like it if I could catch him.
