Road Conditions: Wet but good surface, tight and twisty.

- 89. Andreas Mikkelsen (NOR) / Anders Jaeger (NOR) (Hyundai i20 Coupe WRC) Very difficult, very hard to push. It felt a little bit better but it's still bad.
- 5. Kris Meeke (GBR) / Sebastian Marshall (GBR) (Toyota Yaris WRC) It took me a while to get a rhythm, it's so narrow in here. It's different from the rest of the rally.
- 10. Jari-Matti Latvala (FIN) / Miikka Anttila (FIN) (Toyota Yaris WRC)
 I lost the rear in oversteer, I turned in and got it back. The rear was a little bit in the ditch but no dramas.
- 3. Teemu Suninen (FIN) / Jarmo Lehtinen (FIN) (Ford Fiesta WRC) It's really difficult. Difficult to be on the limit everywhere but we need to try and push.
- 4. Esapekka Lappi (FIN) / Janne Ferm (FIN) (Citroen C3 WRC) I don't know what happened. I can't do any better to be honest.
- 33. Elfyn Evans (GBR) / Scott Martin (GBR) (Ford Fiesta WRC)
 It's good. The feeling was good and everything was working ok. A busy stage. I wish my pace was the same last night but there we go.

- 42. Craig Breen (IRL) / Paul Nagle (IRL) (Hyundai i20 Coupe WRC) I had guite a good feeling in the car.
- 21. Kalle Rovanperä (FIN) / Jonne Halttunen (FIN) (Skoda Fabia R5 Evo) It was OK, it was really difficult with smaller sections and new pace notes but it was ok.
- 23. Gus Greensmith (GBR) / Elliott Edmondson (GBR) (Ford Fiesta R5 Mkii)
 Pretty hectic. Serious bit of road. Felt like I was pushing but didn't feel like I was carrying the right speed which is never good.
- 22. Mads Ostberg (NOR) / Torstein Eriksen (NOR) (Citroen C3 R5) Not an easy stage, difficult to find a rhythm. Not so easy.

- 41. Benito Guerra (MEX) / Jaime Zapata (MEX) (Skoda Fabia R5 Evo)
 It's difficult, it's not easy. The time is good but... it's the first stage of the forest and it's a long rally. Not so bad.
